The scholarship competition is open to any high school senior in Mississippi whose parent, guardian or grandparent is a member of the MMCCA in good standing and who plans to attend an accredited community college, college or university. To apply, a student must (1) complete the application form, (2) a letter why the student feels they should receive the scholarship (3) letter of recommendation from school official and or city official, and (4) all supporting information as stated in the application. Any application that does not contain all the requested material will not be considered.
